Grading Guidelines: Spring 2020

What do grading guidelines from OSPI look like in the ISD?

- Letter grades as outlined in the syllabus by the teacher.
- Student will not earn grade *lower* than what they had at school closure (MT3 or March 12th).
- All students have opportunity to earn higher grade by engaging meaningfully with coursework.
- No student will earn an F. Students will earn a letter grade (A-D) or an Incomplete.

What do I need to know about baseline grades?

- Baseline = MT3 or March 12th – whichever is higher
- Student MT3 adjusted grades could be higher than posted MT3 grades if student turned in/resubmitted work during the “Enrichment” phase of our closure (March 13th – April 10th)

How could a student earn an Incomplete (three *possible* scenarios)?

- Student had an F at MT3/March 12. The student engaged in new content teaching and learning (April 20th – end of year), but graded work did not improve the student’s grade by the end of semester 2.
- Student had an F at MT3/March 12. The student did not engage in new content teaching and learning (April 20th – end of year).
- Student received an A-D letter grade MT3/March 12th and did not engage in new content teaching and learning (April 20th – end of year).

What do I need to know about engagement?

- Engagement = making an *attempt* to complete essential learning activities and assessments (April 20th – end of year). These are communicated by the teacher.
- Students who are not engaging will be contacted by the teacher.
